Venue

The Badminton competitions will take place at the RWE Rhein-Ruhr sports hall. There will be five or six courts that comply with international standard.



OC-Office

The organisation committee's office will be at the RWE Rhein-Ruhr hall from 27 September till 06 October.

Hotels – Accommodation

As soon as negotiations with hotels at Muehlheim are finished we will offer two hotels with favourable prices. Reservations will have to be made by participating countries themselves





Transport

The DGS will organise transportation on the location (between hotel and sports hall) and also the transfer from and to Muehlheim main-station. We advise all participants that want to travel by air to go to either Duesseldorf or Weeze airport. The costs for transfer from Duesseldorf airport to the hotel and back will be 10,00 EURO, from Weeze airport and back 20,00 EURO p.p..



Arrival/Training

The official training will take place on 28 September at the RWE Rhein-Ruhr hall. Therefore we recommend that you arrive on 27 September.

ISCD Inspection

ICSC TD Martin Bogard will inspect the sports hall in January 2007 during the Yonex Open Championships and meet the organising committee for discussions about the WC.



Program

The official program for the WC will be made by Martin Bogard in due time. On 29 September at 10:00 am the opening ceremony will take place and at 11:00 am the matches will start. There will be a reception of the city of Muelheim and the DGS for officials and guests of honour at 12:00 am. Till 06 October there will be daily matches. In the evening of 06 October the closing banquet will be at the sports hall.



Technical Meeting

The first technical meeting will presumably be on 28 October at 05:00 pm.

Closing Banquet

Costs for the closing banquet will be 20,00 EURO p.p., including dinner and program.

Accreditation

Every participant of the World Deaf Badminton Championships will receive an identification card with his photo. This card will give him access to enter the sports hall for all matches.
